2017 Oregon State Senior Qualifying Tournament

PLEASE READ ALL TOURNAMENT RULES BEFORE COMPLETING ENTRY

All entrants must be at least 50 years of age and be a current member in good standing of the Oregon State USBC. Current members of any Professional Bowlers Association will NOT be permitted to bowl this tournament.

There are six separate classifications of qualifying (based on age at the time of qualifying) for both Open and Women's Divisions. See front of entry form for the age classifications. Be sure to circle the Division (Open or Women's) you are competing in, and check the appropriate box for your age classification as of the date you are bowling.

Qualifying consists of two 3-game blocks (6 games total) and total scores will include handicap. Entrants may compete only once (2 squads, 6 games total). All six games may be completed in one day or over any two days.

AVERAGES: Averages will be determined in the following order:

- 1) Highest 21+ game standard/house average for 2016-17 (including summer); if none,
- 2) Highest 21+ game standard/house average for 2015-16 (including summer); if none,
- 3) Current standard/house average of 21 games or more; if none,
- 4) Enter at 210

If the only average available is a Sport or Challenge average, it will be adjusted per USBC rule 201. Rule 319a will apply if a bowler has a current average of 21 games or more that is 10 pins or more higher than their highest 2015-16 or 2014-15 average. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average.

HANDICAP: Handicap is based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 230.

The highest handicap 6-game series bowled in each age classification will receive a paid entry into the USBC National Senior Championships, a championship shirt, and reimbursement of up to \$200 for travel expenses (upon completion of the trip and furnishing OSUSBC receipts for expenses). In the event of a tie after 6 games of qualifying, the winner or higher place will be determined by the high single game with handicap. If a tie still exists, the second highest game with handicap, or third and so on will be used to determine the higher award. Prize fund will be returned 100% with at least one prize for every eight entries in each age classification.

Errors in scoring and/or calculation must be reported within 24 hours of the time bowled. Obvious errors will be corrected by the Tournament Manager.

Each entrant hereby agrees that the Oregon State USBC, it's officers or agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if the entrant shall be prevented from bowling the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by way of national emergencies, or causes relating to fires, lockouts, labor difficulties, or other causes beyond the control of the OSUSBC and the Senior Qualifying Tournament.

Any situation not covered by these rules shall be governed by the USBC tournament rules. All entrants give their express permission to the Oregon State USBC for the use of the entrant's name, photograph and/or likeness in any form and/or media without compensation of any kind.

FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: Oregon State USBC.
